


### **Avoid Fraud**

Separate authorization of expenses from bookkeeping



### Reporting to your State

Podcast

Typically three state agencies

- Secretary of State: Nonprofit incorporation annual report
- Attorney General: Charitable Solicitation (donations and fundraisers) registration and maybe an annual report
- Taxation: Sales tax exemption on purchases and sometimes on sales

## Virginia Reporting

**Nonprofit corporation:** Annual Report (\$25 fee) due end of month of Incorporation.

Virginia will remind you!

**Charitable Solicitation Registration** 

Look for exceptions

 Exemptions from registering and reporting if solicitations are under \$5,000/year; members only; 5 or fewer contiguous counties. File Form 100

Sales Tax. Exemption on purchases. File Form NP-1.

Must collect sales tax on *regular sales* of tangible personal property. Can be exempt if buying to resell. Form ST-10
